

**PA AOH License Plate
Frequently Asked Questions**

? I see that PA DOT requires \$20 for the Specialty Plate. So is the fee for the AOH Plate \$40 or \$60?

The AOH License plate costs a total of \$40.00, which includes the PA DOT fee of \$20. The new plate will come with one new registration card. If you want additional cards, they cost \$1.50 each on top of the \$40.00.

? Can I choose my own numbers or personalize the plate?

Unfortunately, no. PA DOT issues plates in sequential order after the first batch of 100 applications are received. Special organization plates cannot be personalized.

? I have a handicapped license plate. Can I get this plate with the handicapped logo?

PA DOT is unable to offer an AOH Specialty Plate with the handicapped insignia on it. A brother can apply for a person with a disability placard. This will afford you the same parking privileges as a person with a disability plate. This can be obtained on-line at www.dmv.state.pa.us The form you need is MV-145A.

? My registration is due soon (or I just renewed my registration). What should I do?

Don't let your registration lapse! Renew your registration as normal. Purchasing the AOH Specialty Plate does not automatically renew your registration. You will not be paying twice for the AOH Specialty Plate, as the \$40 is the fee for the Specialty Plate and does not affect your registration. When your AOH Specialty Plate arrives, it will have a new registration card and sticker with your expiration date. It does not matter at what point in the vehicle registration cycle that you get this plate.

? How long does the license plate application process take? (When will I finally get my plate?)

Applications are taken to PA DOT in batches around the 15th and 30th of each month. Once PA DOT receives an application it takes about 6 weeks until you receive your license plate. This is because the plates are not pre-made. They are made in sequential order as applications are submitted and mailed to you from Harrisburg.

? What vehicles are eligible to display an AOH plate?

PA DOT's Specialty Plates are restricted to passenger vehicles, trucks and motor homes with a registered weight of not more than 9,000 lbs. Motorcycles and trailers do not qualify for Specialty Plates.

? I purchased a plate on-line using PayPal. Is there anything more that I must do?

Yes! Please complete the two forms then sign and send them to the PA AOH License Plate Post Office Box. (P.O. Box 6143, Harrisburg, PA 17112)

? Who must sign the PA DOT MV-904SP?

Anyone listed on the current vehicle registration must add their information and sign the MV-904SP (spouses?!).

? Can I purchase the PA AOH Specialty Plate directly from PA DOT?

No. The Specialty Plate application must be verified by an AOH License Plate coordinator before it is sent to PA DOT. All applications received by PA DOT are returned to the AOH for verification – delaying processing.

? What role does Dauphin County, Division 1 play in this process?

Dauphin County, Division 1 (DC, D1) has assumed responsibility for the coordination and submission of all AOH Specialty License Plate applications to PA DOT. Acting with the permission of the State Board, DC, D1 submitted the AOH application to

PA DOT in 2006 and managed its ultimate approval. Further, DC, D1 extended all application fees and now pays all associated costs.
